What Does August Symbolise?

August is another warm month with solar themes and fun in the sun – at least in the Northern Hemisphere. It signals the dwindling down of summer and the approaching autumn. Like the other months, August was given its name by the Romans. It was originally the sixth month of the year, before January and February were added by Numa Pompilius around 700 B.C. As such, its original name was the Latin Sextili. In 8 B.C., the name was changed to August to honor the emperor Augustus. A Senatus consultum states that Augustus chose this month because several of his great triumphs occurred then, including his conquest of Egypt.
