





# **Brook House Bake Off!**



A group of us really enjoyed a little trip out to Ullesthorpe Garden Centre, where we enjoyed some cake, tea and coffee in the café.


Considering that we haven't been able to do this very often lately, it was a lovely treat to journey out a little bit and we look forward to it becoming a weekly occurance again here at Brook House!


