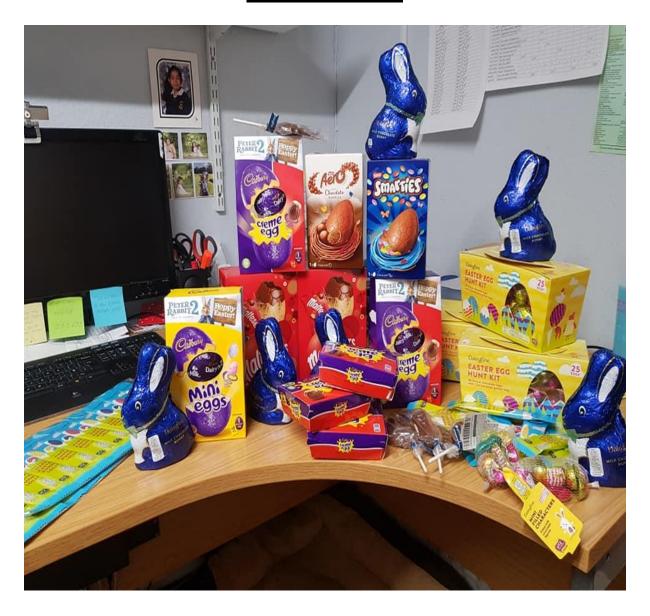


I hope everyone had a wonderful bank holiday Easter weekend, the weather was scorching and we've enjoyed several sunny days since then!

We also had a Ukulele afternoon with Gail, it was a beautiful sunny afternoon and everyone sat out in the garden.

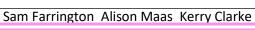

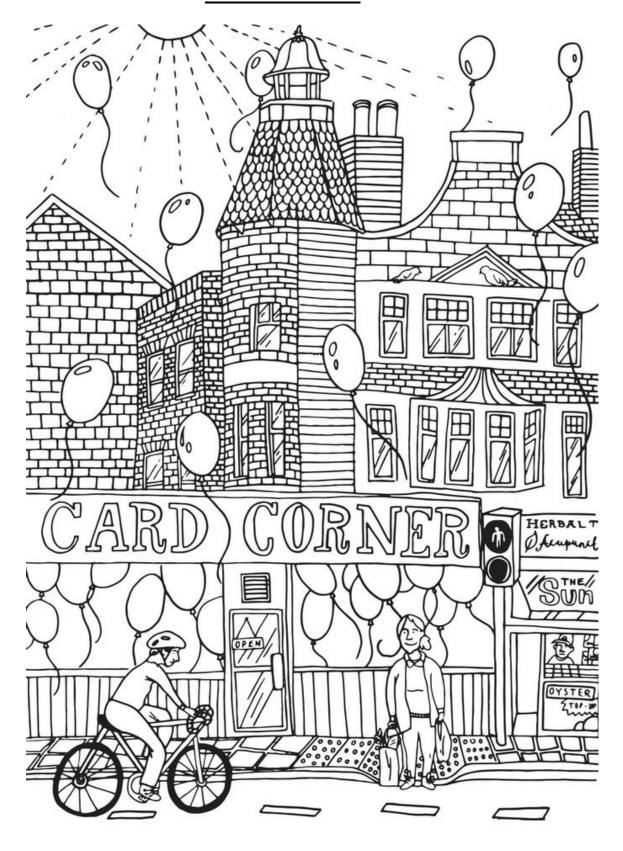

May Recipe

<u>INGREDIENTS</u>

MINI LEMON DROP CUPCAKES

- 1 box lemon cake mix
- 1 box instant vanilla pudding 3.4 oz, dry mix
- 4 large eggs
- 1 1/4 cups sour cream or yogurt
- 1/2 cup milk

EASY LEMON GLAZE

- 3 1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 2 tsp grated lemon zest from 1 lemon
- 2 TBSP unsalted butter melted
- 1/4 cup fresh lemon juice from 1 lemon
- 1/4 cup hot water



INSTRUCTIONS

TO MAKE THE MINI LEMON CUPCAKES:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 325 F. Coat mini muffin tin with cooking spray.
- 2. Beat the ingredients in a large bowl with an electric mixer for several minutes until blended and smooth. Fill each muffin hole about 1/2 full. I used a small cookie scoop and it worked perfectly! Bake for about 12 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean.
- 3. Cool the pan on a wire rack for about 2 minutes and then turn the muffin pan over on a wire rack so that all the muffins are upside down.
- 4. Cool completely and once all the batter is cooked, you can make the glaze.

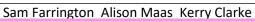
TO MAKE THE LEMON GLAZE:

- 1. Place the wire racks over waxed paper. Beat the glaze ingredients in a medium bowl until smooth.
- 2. Dip muffins in glaze to coat the bottoms (which are now the tops!) and the sides and let the excess drip off back into the bowl.
- 3. Place each lemon drop back on the wire racks until the glaze is set.

Thomas Moore (born 30 April 1920), known as Captain Tom, is a former British Army officer known for his efforts to raise money for charity in the run-up to his 100th birthday during the 2020 coronavirus pandemic.

Moore served in India and the Burma campaign during the Second World War. He later became an instructor in armoured warfare.

After the war, he worked as managing director of a concrete company and was an avid motorcycle racer. On 6 April 2020, at the age of 99, he began to walk around his garden in aid of NHS Charities Together during the COVID-19 pandemic, with the goal of raising £1,000 by his hundredth birthday. By 26 April he had raised over £29 million. In doing so, he made many media appearances and became a popular household name in the United Kingdom generating much interest in his life story, and earned a number of accolades. Soon after the walk, he featured in a cover version of the song "You'll Never Walk Alone", with proceeds going to the same charity. The single topped the UK music charts and made him the oldest person to ever achieve a UK number one
