
Westcroft Nursing Home 3b Exceptional Exceptional Exceptional

Notable Dates in September

September 7—the first Monday in September—is <u>Labor Day</u>. Canadians also observe Labour Day.

September 11 is **Patriot Day**, held in honor and remembrance of those who died in the September 11 attacks of 2001.

September 13 is **Grandparents Day**. Honor your grandparents today—and every day!

September 17 is **Constitution Day**. This day celebrates the adoption of the U.S.Constitution, which occurred on September 17, 1787 (just five years prior to the founding of *The Old Farmer's Almanac*, believe it or not!).

September 18 brings the start of **Rosh Hashanah**, at sundown.

September 21 is recognized as the annual <u>International Day of</u>

<u>Peace</u>. Observances range from a moment of silence at noon to events such as peace walks, concerts, and volunteering in the community.

September 22 marks the start of fall! This year's <u>Autumnal</u> <u>Equinox</u> falls on September 22 at 9:31 A.M. EDT. At this time, there are approximately equal hours of daylight and darkness.

September 27 is **Yom Kippur**, the holiest holiday in the Jewish calendar.

September 29 is <u>Michaelmas</u>. Michaelmas is an ancient Celtic "Quarter Day" which marked the end of the harvesting season and was steeped in folklore.
