We have been awarded a national Gold Standards Framework (GSF) Quality Hallmark Award in recognition of the excellent end of life care we provide. We received the award at the GSF annual conference and awards ceremony on Friday 26th September at East Side Rooms in Birmingham - a celebration of the UK's exceptional health and social care providers for care in the final year of life. We were one of 172 organisations from across the country receiving the award in Birmingham (139 care homes, 1 primary care team, 10 domiciliary care agencies, 3 retirement villages, 1 prison healthcare team, 1 hospice team and 17 hospital




