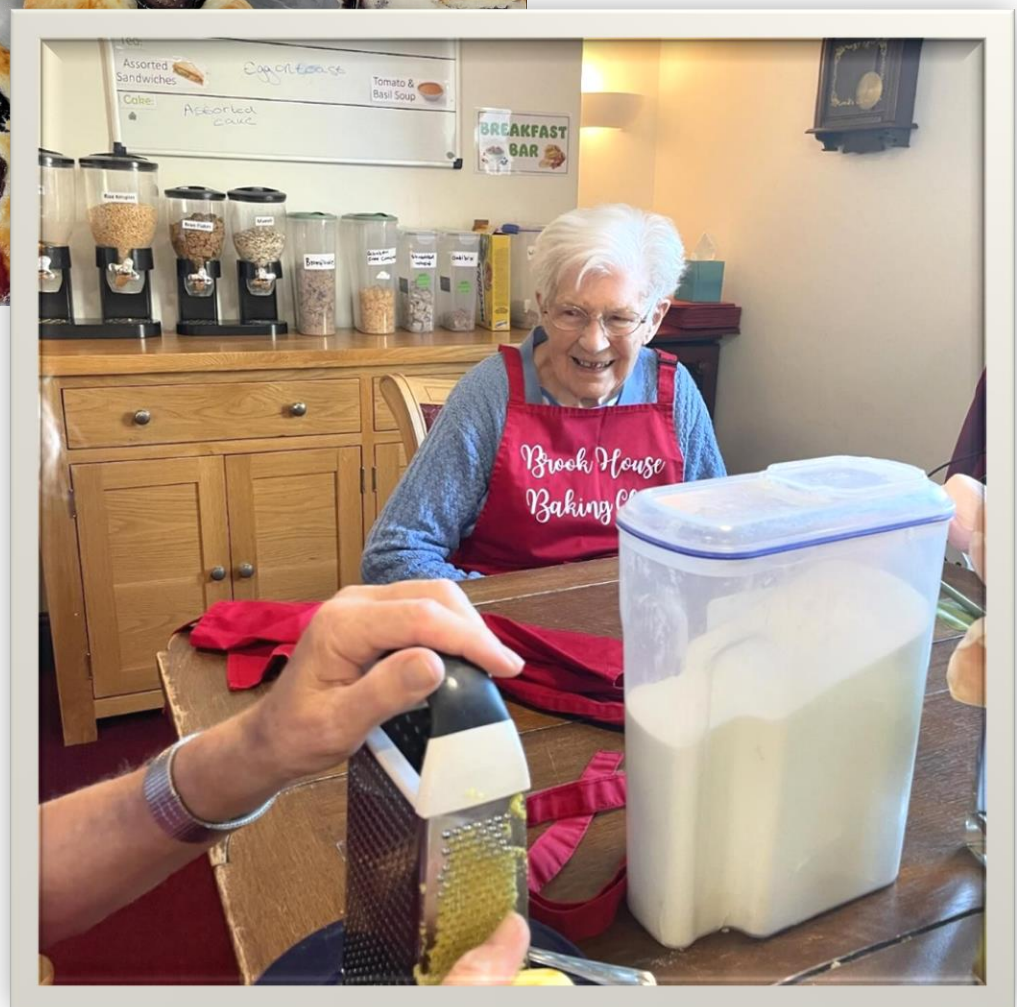
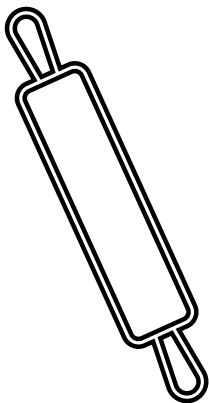
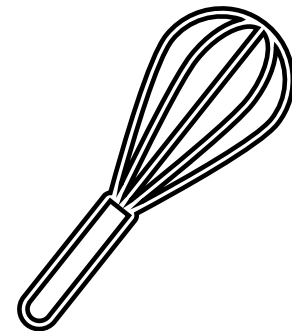
September has been a busy month with baking club, minibus trips, and much more!

Baking

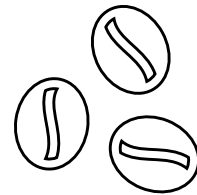
We have been loving getting hands on when baking after lunchtime. We have been experimenting with some different treats and so far, we thought our Lemon and Blueberry Scones were our favourite!

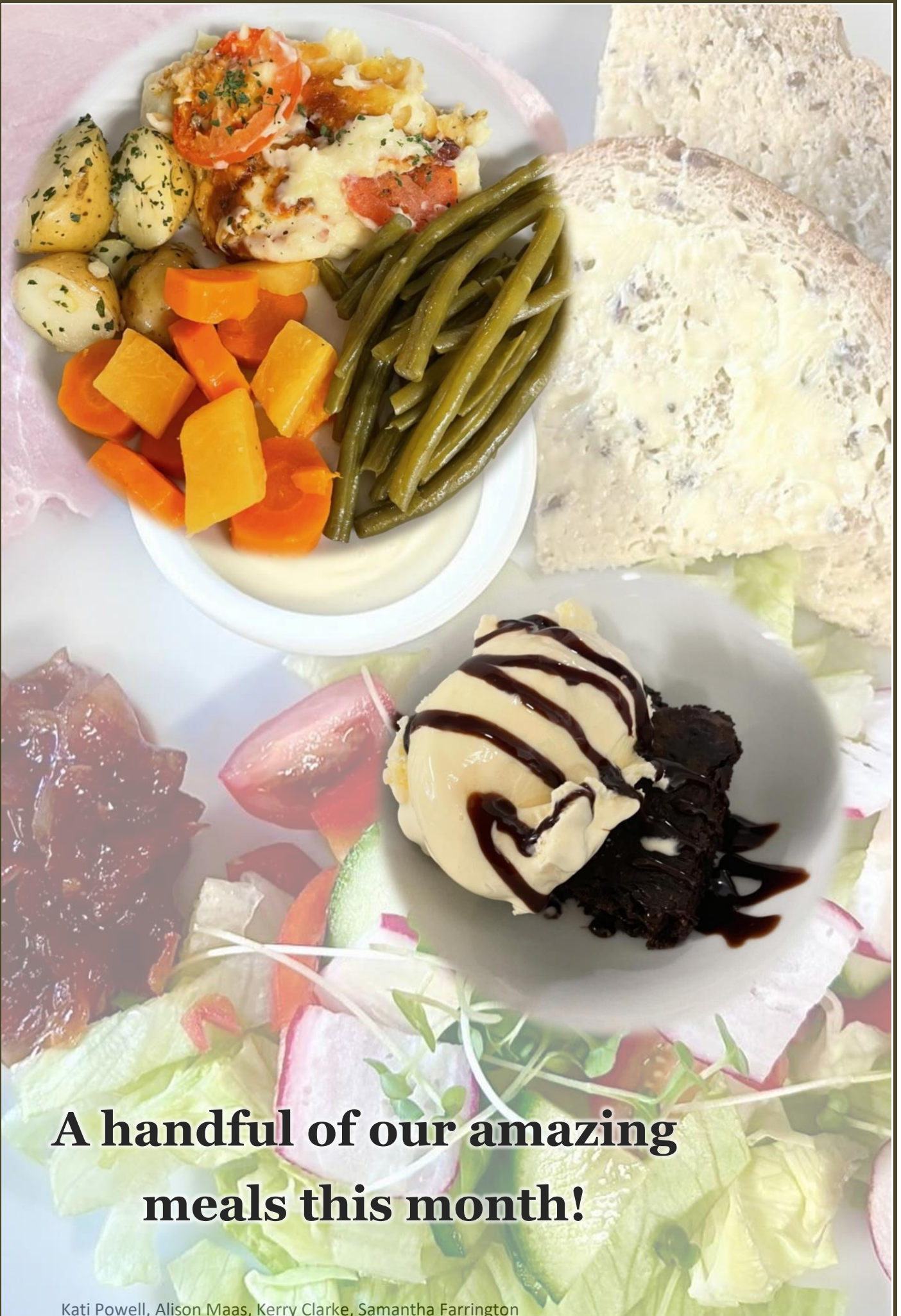
