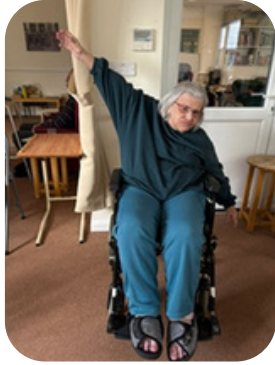


Mental exercises

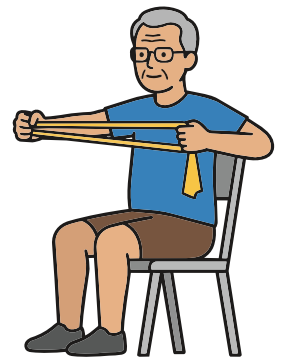
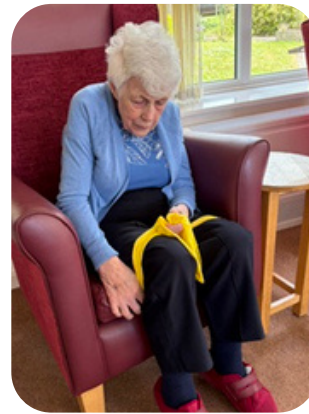

Spiritual



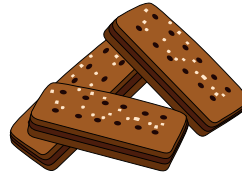

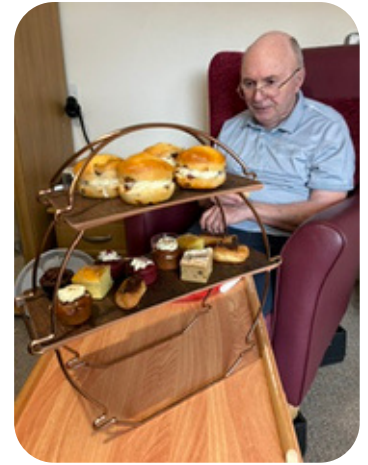
Getting out and About



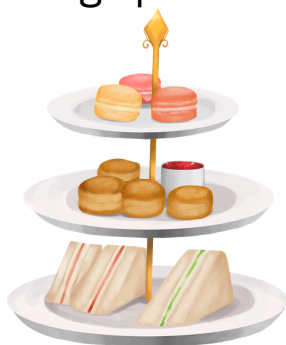

Afternoon Tea with Holiday Inn

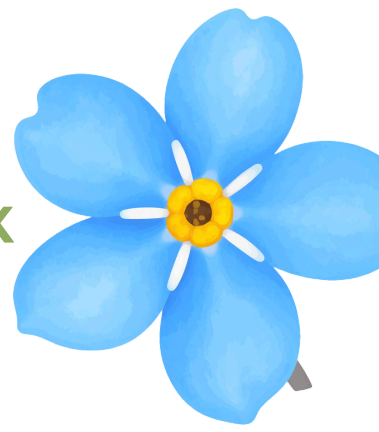


We had a lovely offer from Holiday Inn to provide afternoon tea for our residents. They came and presented it beautifully and the residents loved being spoilt.

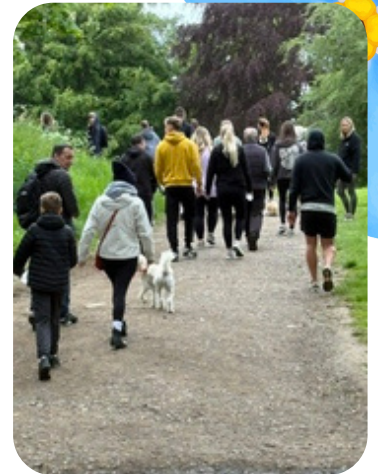
Dementia Awareness Walk



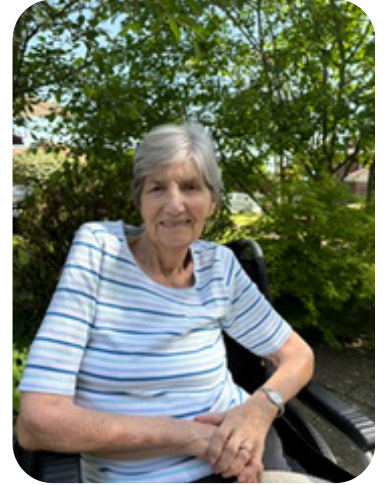

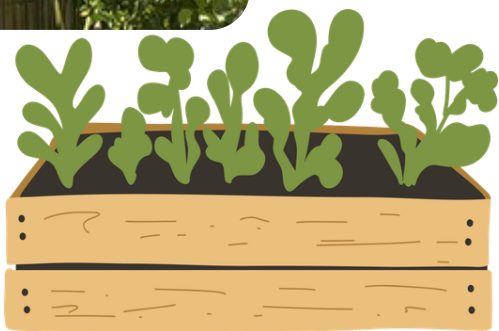
Time enjoying the sunshine and keeping an eye on the seeds growing in the greenhouse.



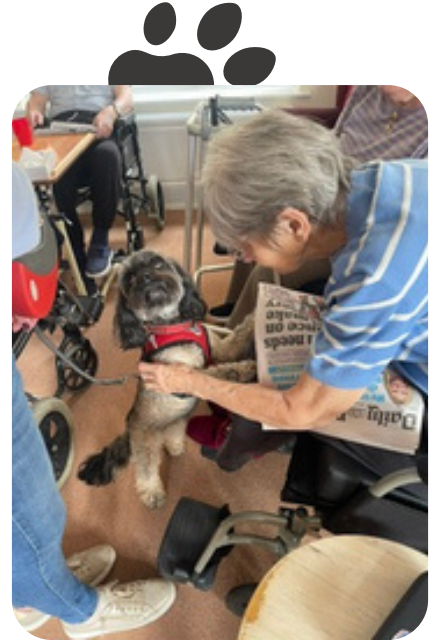

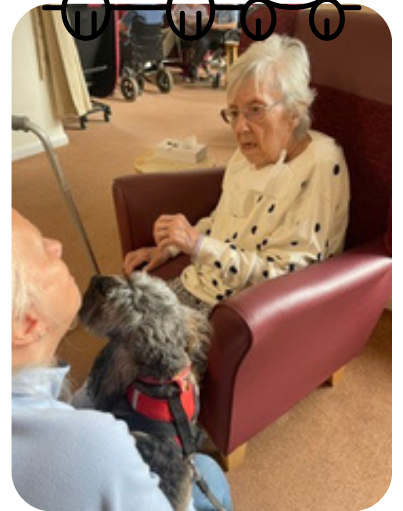
Keeping an eye on our baby birds nesting in the bird box, we missed them fledging but lovely to know the houses have been used.

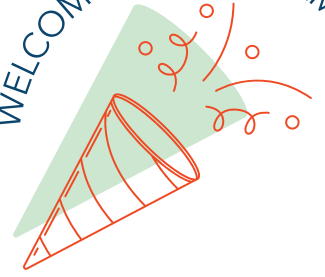

Our new member of staff joining us at Saintbridge in May is Lee. He has joined us as a senior carer and is settling in well and getting to know all our residents and their characters.

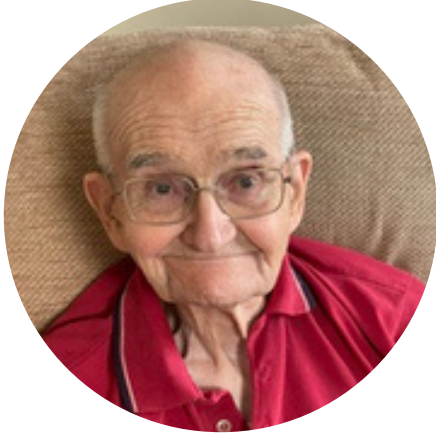

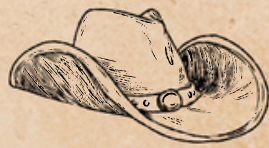
