# The King's Official Birthday 17th Jun 2023

Celebrations of the monarch's official birthday are held in June across the Commonwealth and include the Trooping of the Colour in London.

There have been 13 British monarchs since the political union of the Kingdom of England and the Kingdom of Scotland on 1 May 1707. There was two previous King Charles before and both reigned during one of the most turbulent periods in British history. The current monarch - King Charles III - chose his Christian name as his official name, much like his mother, Queen Elizabeth II, who died on Thursday, September 8, 2022.



June 20th or 21st is the date of the Summer Solstice in the Northern Hemisphere.


It is the day that has the longest amount of daylight during the year.
