

Fun Facts For September

• September is the only month with the same number of letters in its name as the number of the month: it is the ninth month and has nine letters.

• The Anglo-Saxons called September Gerst Monath (Barley Month) or Haefest Monath (Harvest Month) celebrating the barley harvest.

• September (from the Latin septem, seven) was the seventh month of the old Roman calendar.

- In the UK, September 26 is the most common birthday for people born in the last 20 years.
- On an average September day more babies are born in the US than on a day in any other month

• September is the worst month for share prices which on average lose one per cent of their value.

This month in history

- 1666 The <u>Great Fire of London</u> begins in Pudding Lane and rages for 5 days, but kills only 9 people..
- 1939 Britain and France declare war on Germany.
- 1962 The Beatles start their first recording session at EMI's Abbey Road Studios, London
- 1620 The Mayflower sets sail from <u>Plymouth</u>, <u>Devon</u>, carrying the Pilgrim Fathers to America.
- 1902 Harry Jackson becomes the first person in Britain to be convicted on fingerprint evidence.
- 1709 Birth of Samuel Johnson, compiler of the first English dictionary.
- 1944 The first V2 flying bombs kill 3 people in London.
- 1701 King James II of England died whilst in exile in France.
- 1735 Britain's first <u>Prime Minister</u>, Sir Robert Walpole moves in to <u>10 Downing Street</u>.
- 1848 Chewing gum is produced commercially for the first time.
- 1776 The first St. Leger <u>horserace</u> is run at Doncaster, <u>Yorkshire</u>.
- 1818 First transfusion of human blood is performed at Guy's Hospital, <u>London</u>.
- 1580 The Golden Hind arrives in Plymouth harbour having sailed round the world under the captaincy of <u>Sir Francis Drake</u>. Drake plundered a few Spanish ships en-route to keep morale high!

What Does September Symbolise?

The **symbolism** of **September** month focuses on refocusing our energies. In the Northern Hemisphere, it signals the beginning of autumn, while it kicks off the spring season in the South. Like the other months, its name comes from the ancient Romans. It comes from the Latin septum, meaning "seven".

Astronomically, you can enjoy the Aurigids and the Delta Aurigids meteor showers from Mid-September through the end of the month. Additionally the Southern Taurids come into the sky from September 10th. The last 5 months provide a peak at the Andromedids shower
